Parents are one of the biggest and most important influences in a child's life. In order to have a successful team, it is vital that parents support, honor, and encourage all team endeavors through their words and actions.

Also, any person acting as a guardian (stepparent, grandparent, etc.) is also expected to behave in accordance with this policy at all team sponsored events.

- _____ Because the danceline will have year round events, parents will spend a great deal of time with this activity.
- _____ Parents and Coaches must have a mutual respect towards each other at all times. Although differences of opinions may arise at times, it is imperative that the parents and coaches continue to be the adults in every situation. **A respectful discussion can occur once the event has ENDED and the team is dismissed. This is out of respect for the team members.*
- _____ Parents must recognize that the Coach has the final say as to whether or not your child will participate in performances with the team.
- _____ Just as we expect our dancers to uphold good sportsmanship and character so too must the parents representing our team. All parents/guardians or *those persons acting on behalf of any dancer* (including but not limited to step-parents, grandparents, etc.) are expected to be mindful of their words and actions while representing the Troydolls at all games, performances, competitions, fundraisers, and any other team sponsored events.
- _____ Parents WILL be called upon to help throughout the year and are expected to make every effort to assist on behalf of their dancer.
- _____ All practices are closed. We need to have the dancer's full attention during practices and can accomplish more without parents, siblings, and friends moving in and out of the practice area.

_____ If you need to speak with the coaches, please wait until the team has been dismissed from practice or the performing event.

_____ It is required that each dancer and a parent/guardian be present for all parent meetings.

_____ Parents will not be permitted in pre-performance areas or dressing rooms unless designated by the coach as the room/team mom for that particular performance

_____ Parents must be fully aware of all rules and regulations in the ASH Troydolls Constitution and Demerit System should any team rules or expectations be violated.

_____ Parents are expected to be mindful and supportive of our behavior, practice, performance, competition, attendance, fund raiser, grade, and payment policies as outlined in the ASH Troydolls Constitution.

_____ ***Warning: Dancers may be penalized for extreme behavior exhibited by parent(s) up to and including removal from the team.***
